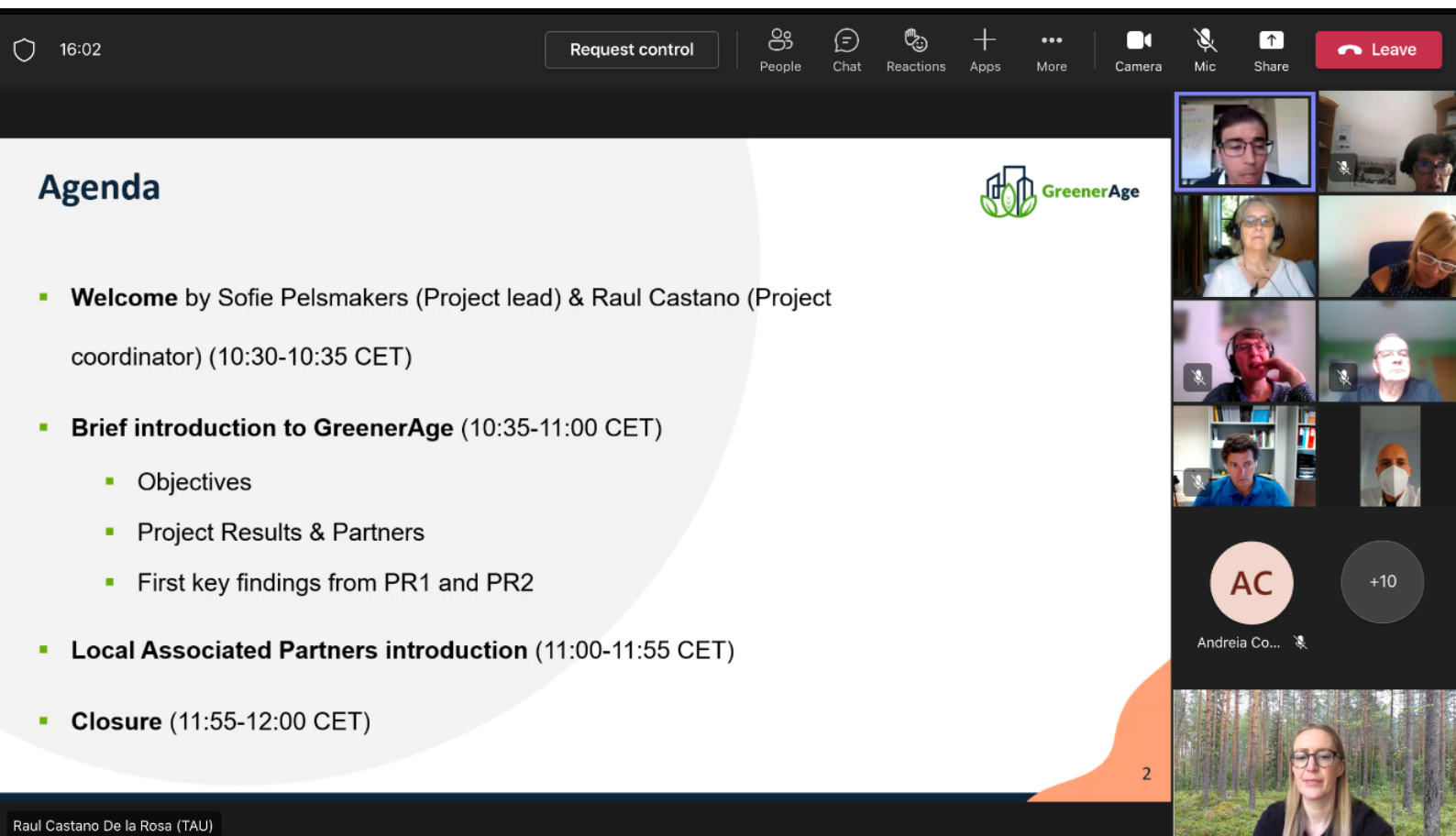

IN THE SPOTLIGHT

INTERNATIONAL ASSOCIATED PARTNERS FROM 5 COUNTRIES MET ON 21ST JUNE



The GreenerAge project aims to create a low-threshold and playful access to an environmental and digital literacy platform for citizens 55+, promoting a self-reflecting, positive and empowering tool for environmental and climatic issues.

To achieve these objectives and disseminate the results achieved, the participation of associated partners is fundamental and for that reason the consortium established several partnerships with local, regional, and national and transnational organisations of relevance to the topic.

On June 21st, GreenerAge held an international online meeting that gathered the project team and the Associated Partners in a fruitful discussion: Santa Casa da Misericórdia de Seia – Portugal, ITECONS – Portugal, Ordem dos Engenheiros – Portugal, European Association for the Education of Adults (EAEA) – Finland, Ekokumppanit Oy – Finland, Tampere University Steering group – Finland, Tyska Rada Seniorów – Poland, Krajowy Instytut Gospodarki Senioralnej – Poland, Metropolia GZM – Poland, and as the responsible official of the Municipality of Maintal could not participate, he had his presentation read by ISIS.

The meeting started with a brief presentation of the GreenerAge project, and the main objectives and results intended. The project team took the chance to present the first key findings from the Project Result 1 and 2 – the compendium about environment and climatic literacy and the interactive learning platform.

The Associated Partners of GreenerAge presented their assets and explained how they will specifically participate in the project; namely, to support participant recruitment and dissemination activities; direct and advise on content planning; give feedback about the content developed in different stages; and support the organization of local stakeholders focus groups, workshops, tests, and interviews.

As a result of this first meeting with the Associated Partners, it is worth highlighting the interest and commitment shown by each of the organisations to implement the objectives of the GreenerAge project.
